- Rally is now a recognised Kennel Club discipline and is open to all breeds and types of canine and requires support from the owner/handler, rather than an intense and high level of handling. - Chieveley Village Hall is 4 miles north of Newbury and accessible from the A34 : www.mychieveley.co.uk and <https://www.facebook.com/Chieveley>
- The workshop will be held in a safe, indoor environment. Open to dogs over the age of 20 weeks. No previous Rally training is necessary.
- This workshop is aimed at Lagotto owners, but open to other breed owners and also to interested trainers from other disciplines.
- The workshop is limited to 10 dogs/handlers. Spectators without dogs are welcome (max. 30). Only dogs involved in the workshop (on leads) can be in the hall during the training sessions. Handlers - Bring bedding/crate and water bowl for your dog's comfort inside. Extra dogs may be crated in the hall, but outside the training area, or remain in your vehicles, **under your own supervision**.
- Please bring **lots of high value treats**, a fine or flat collar and light lead, clicker, tug toys, any other (non-coercive) training aids you use that help with focus in what will be a distracting environment. Wear clothing that allows quick access to treats etc. eg. gilet/light coat with pockets. Short 'times out' are essential!
- Dogs that require 'space' can be accommodated, but please advise details below on the booking form and email relevant details to me prior to the workshop. Space and entry/exit options are limited.
- The morning session will comprise a) an introduction to Level 1 and 2 static signs (followed by discussion), b) the moving signs and c) some active work on achieving heel connection and d) linking. After lunch we will work a few signs together. To close, a short course will be available to try out with your dogs. We will close with discussion and feedback.
